Pal—adopted by Missy in Missouri.

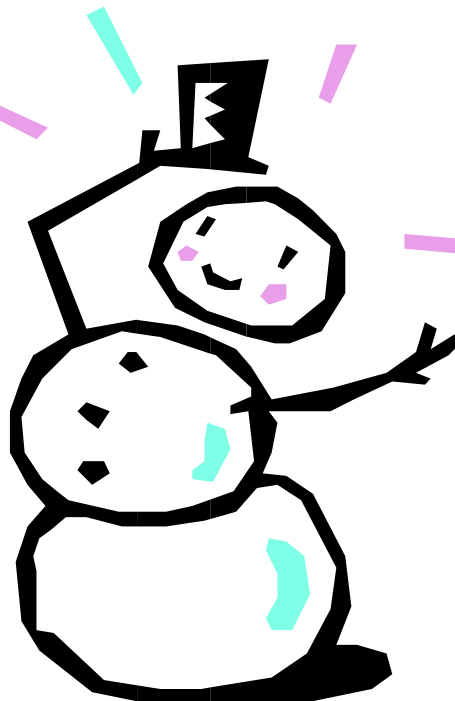
Pal came into CMHR custody and was adopted out very quickly. We didn't even have time to get his photos and get him up on the adoption page.
